# Microeconomic Perspectives on Quality of Care

## Winter Term 2023/24

The aim of the course is to introduce you to microeconomic analysis which deals with quality issues with a focus on quality in health care.

We cover material from two branches of economics:

- (1) "Industrial Economics": a branch of economics which analyses firm behavior in settings of imperfect markets.
- (2) "Contract Theory": This branch analyses principal-agent relationships and optimal contracts.

The course is theoretical. The idea is to focus on conceptual issues which will be helpful for your further research.

### Tasks and Assessment

Students will be randomly assigned to groups and present scientific articles. Presentations start on October 27<sup>th</sup>.

The second task is to write a short paper with a length of 1,500 to 2,000 words (text without bibliography) related to the course material.

Students will develop the topic themselves and hand it an exposé (one page without bibliography) until **December 11**<sup>th</sup>. Feedback will be given until December 19<sup>th</sup>.

The short paper is due January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

Grading: presentation (1/3) and short paper (2/3).
